As a result ... some of the delicious details are:

- 1) Culinary experiences in Buenos Aires, the "Paris of South America."
- 2) Tour of areas of historical significance in Buenos Aires, including the famous Recoleta Cemetery where Eva Peron is buried.
- 3) A fast ferry trip to Colonia del Sacramento in Uruguay. It is the oldest town in Uruguay, was founded by Portugal, and is noted for its historic quarter. We'll tour, taste regional foods, and visit an estancia (a cattle ranch, and MUCH more! Read about it in the trip details!)
- 4) A plane ride (it takes 13 hours by bus!) to the Mendoza wine region. Much touring, tasting, culinary experiences.
- 5) Scheduled in the spring during the less expensive "shoulder season" and before the Easter/Passover holidays, and while it is still warm (seasons are reversed in South America).
